July Association Meeting Minutes July 21, 2006 Glendale Mall Public Library

1:00 P Association meeting called to order:

1) Brain Injury Association Conference – Amy Flint

Motion -Would INABC like exhibit at conference Sept 21 & 22? TBI, depression, anxiety topics

- Exhibit is \$400 which includes 2 slots for attendance; Professional Liaison Committee will organize shifts to be at booth.
- Passed unanimously.
- 2) Bull\$%&* Bingo: Activity
- 3) Ethics report from May meeting: Voting protocol

Recommended Bylaws revisions:

Section 1) of Bylaws – add "51% of voting members and 51% of agencies voting must vote yes to pass motion – use sign in sheet – Discussion - does this apply to officers - agreed Motion for this issue: Unanimously passed.

Section 2) <u>Executive board membership</u> – any member can become a board member after 24 months membership in association, present at 66% of meetings for the proceeding 12 months.

Motion: - for issue – Unanimously passed.

Note: Further define individual as are in the context of the bylaws

Section 2) Not more that 2 individuals from the same agency on the executive board $\,$ - discussion -

Motion for issue – Unanimously passed

Committees:

Section 3) Committees <u>must</u> have 51% of the vote by the membership Motion Passed unanimously

Section 3) Minimum and maximum for a committee should be 3 and 7 members. Ad hoc committees can be exempt from this requirement

Motion passed unanimously

Section 3) Committees may hold closed meetings to discuss sensitive materials. Closed meeting: non committee members will not sit in. Exception – president.

Motion – passed unanimously

Section 3) Individuals on committees must attend $2/3^{rd}$ of committee meetings for a 12 month period. 3 consecutive missed meetings will lead to being off of the committee.

Motion passed unanimously

Section 3: A chairperson of a committee must be a member of INABC for 12 months and attendance of 2/3 of assn. meetings.

Motion passed unanimously

Section 3) There is no limit on chairperson's term. Must be reelected each year by committee.

Motion passed.

FROM MAY FORUM – Have vision statement but need to vote on Mission Statement. Suggestions sent in via email. Do we limit our mission to individuals with DD? Decided to use "behavioral difficulties."

Passed – will not limit area of practice. See by-laws for mission statement.

Secretary Report: Jane Ford has had to resign – do we need to nominate another secretary? Motion – have board members volunteer until election. Passed unanimously.

Results of email vote on certification for BMAN as a profession 21 Pro 2 nay 1 abstention.

PRNs – recommended changes to 460 guidelines: Behavior guidelines to be followed prior to use of PRN. PRN should be team decision. Discussion of past issues regarding PRNs. Electronic approvals should be permitted.
